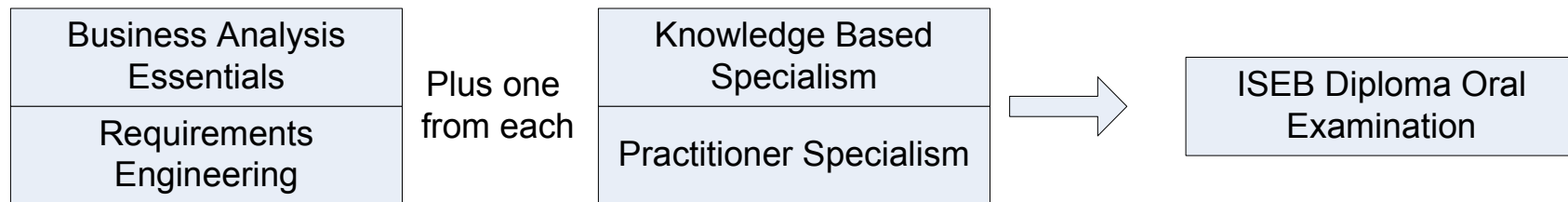

	<p><b>ISEB Practitioner Level – Individual Certificate Modules</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No specific prerequisites for entry to each certificate module</li> <li>• Recommended hours of related training for each certificate module</li> <li>• Candidates must possess the skills and knowledge to enable them to meet the objectives in each module syllabus</li> <li>• 1hr, open book, business scenario based exam for each certificate module</li> </ul>
	<p><b>ISEB Higher Level – Business Analysis Diploma</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Aimed at experienced Business Analysts and Managers</li> <li>• Four individual certificate module passes including 2 core modules: Business Analysis Essentials and Requirements Engineering, plus one knowledge based specialist module and one Practitioner based specialism 50 minute oral examination. Candidates required to demonstrate application and expertise in all areas covered by the four certificate modules plus interpersonal and professional skills</li> </ul>

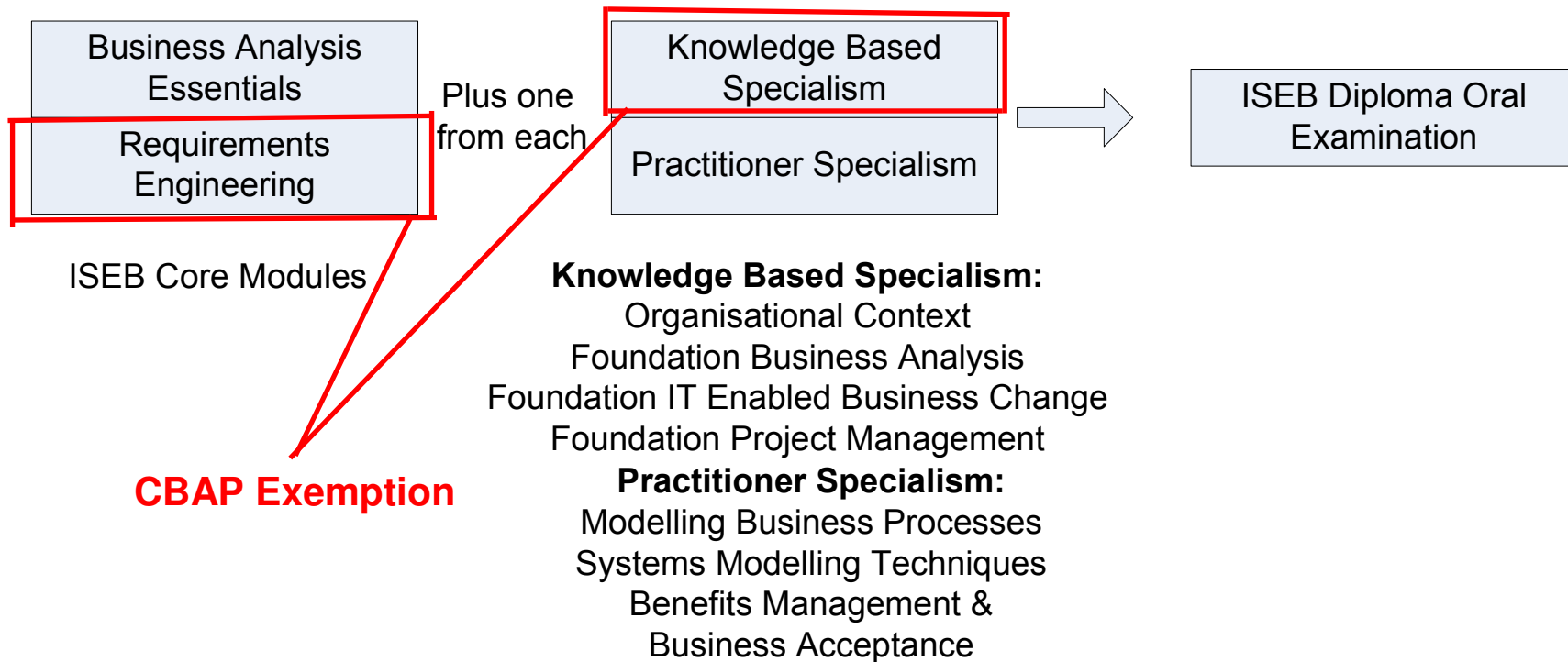
